Funded Research Studentships (2)

Linked to current research into the marginalisation and exclusion of children and young people in Northern Ireland two University research studentships are offered within the Childhood, Transition and Social Justice Initiative. Research proposals are invited from applicants who hold a relevant Masters degree, qualitative research experience and a demonstrable commitment to critical theories of childhood and children's rights. The studentships are fully funded and resourced for three years. The award is £12,940 p.a. tax free plus fees and training support.

Date of Commencement: October 2008 or as soon thereafter. Applications to be submitted by Friday 5 September.

The studentships will be allocated by a cross-disciplinary panel and applicants will not be called for interview.
